On Thursday, February 13, 2025, the 11th Annual Miami County Science Day was held at Tippecanoe High School for students in grades 5-12. This event offered students a venue that promotes the development of creative thinking, research and writing skills and career motivation toward the sciences, all in one program. Seventy-seven students from Tipp City, Miami East, Covington, Piqua, Milton-Union and the Upper Valley Career Center, completed and exhibited projects in animal Science, plant science, chemistry, environmental sciences, computers, microbiology, energy, physics, engineering, mathematics, medicine & health and behavioral & social sciences.
